Several years ago, Kevin & Della Pashley's son Matt was playing for Witham Town FC when he collapsed and was rushed to Basildon Hospital. He was then transferred to Queen's Hospital for emergency surgery when bleeding was discovered on his brain.



Kevin said: "His recovery was a miracle, when he first came round from his operation he couldn't see or feel his legs.

"The staff were amazing, he had his operation at 3am, immediately when he got to Queen's, and that's what saved him. He had 24/7 care and they never left his side that night. I think that was essential to his recovery."

Kevin added: "Our family will never forget the care given at Queen's Hospital and that is why I give a donation regularly every month. It's our way of giving something back."

How much should I give?

The Direct Debit Guarantee

If you request BPS Re King George & Queen's Hospitals Charity to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by BPS Re King George & Queen's Hospitals Charity or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society – if you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when BPS Re King George & Queen's Hospitals Charity asks you to.
